“Therefore, because it was the Preparation *Day*, that the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), the Jews asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and *that* they might be taken away. Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was crucified with Him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs.... For these things were done that the Scripture should be fulfilled, “Not *one* of His bones shall be broken.” And again another Scripture says, “They shall look on Him whom they pierced.” John 19:31-37
